

## Community Council Meeting

March 4, 2020

**DIBELS Update:** 89% of Diamond Ridge students made typical or above typical growth in reading. (Goal was 80%. This year's goal is 85%.) Diamond Ridge had the highest growth of any elementary school in Granite School District! At mid-year, 72% of students were meeting their growth goal. Our goal remains at 85% meeting or exceeding their goal by the end of the year.

**MGP Update:** All teachers in every RISE tested subject area made at least a year's growth with their students. Average growth is 40-60 MGP. 4<sup>th</sup> grade average growth was 66. 5<sup>th</sup> grade average growth was 53. 6<sup>th</sup> grade average growth was 71. All teachers achieved at least year's growth with their students in every tested area, meeting our MGP goal. Seven Diamond Ridge teachers received certificates from the superintendent for achieving MGP greater than 70. Diamond Ridge received one of the "MGP trophies" from the district for being one of the five elementary schools with highest growth district wide! Our goal for this school year is that every teacher, will achieve an MGP of at least 50.
