Agenda

1. March Meeting Minutes Approval: An additional item to the March meeting minutes was suggested. Add item "Vote over email for Trustlands budget approval" with Mrs. Yeamans motion to approve, Bruce Simpson second and all were in favor.
2. Review College and Career Readiness Standards coming in the 2022-2023 school year: The new College and Career Readiness Standards were reviewed. The grade of 1,2,3 or 4 will be based on percentages of time versus observation like it is now.

There are 5 main areas of focus:

- 1) Work Ethic and Resilience: Set personal goals, apply best efforts to achieve them and persevere when faced with challenges and setbacks. Have well grounded sense of confidence, optimism and self efficacy.
- 2) Communication: Communicate effectively to share and understand information in a variety of contexts.
- 3) Respect: Acknowledge differences by looking for the good in everyone, including oneself and show regard for feelings, rights, cultures and traditions.
- 4) Responsibility: Be trustworthy, ethical, reliable and accountable for individual choices and the results produced.
- 5) Dependability: Be reliable and accountable.

To let the Driggs community know about these changes, it was suggested that it be posted on social media, Mr. Peters weekly email, and again at the beginning of the next school year, and a note be sent with report cards. Mrs. Yeamans shared verbage for a note that the 4th grade sends home with their report cards noting the grading scale.

3.
