Eastwood Elementary Parking Lot Safety Guidelines

Morning Drop-Off, Afternoon Pick-Up & Parking

Eastwood Elementary is an amazing school where many choose to bring their children. This is fabulous for all of us but leads to problems in our parking lot. We need everyone's help and cooperation in the parking lot. Please follow the safety procedures below to keep everyone safe.

- Be ready. Children should be ready to exit and enter your vehicle as soon as it stops.
- Drive all the way around the lot, staying in the *right lane* and pulling forward to the *furthest* spot possible.
- Use the drop-off and pick-up lane when your children enter or exit your vehicle.
- Children must enter and exit your vehicle from the passenger side, nearest to the walkway.
- Drivers must remain in their vehicles while in the pick-up lane.
- Please DO NOT use your cell phone while in the school parking lot.
- Display your "Pick-Up" pass so it is clearly visible at all times.
- Once you have your child(ren), signal and pull into the left thru lane to exit.
- If you must enter the school, park in one of the visitor parking areas.
- Do not park in the faculty parking area.
- The only overflow area we have is along Wasatch Boulevard north of the school.
- Do not park on Kiabab Circle or on Wasatch Boulevard in front of or south of the school.
- Students must enter and exit the building using their grade level door.
- Students cannot play on the playground equipment during pick-up.
- To ensure safety, everyone must use the walkways.
