<p>If you do not see all of your students, select this option to add additional students who are enrolled in Granite School District.</p>	<p>An application mainly used by secondary schools. Parents are given an observer's role into the student's courses.</p>	<p>An application mainly used by elementary schools to schedule events such as appointments for Parent Teacher conferences.</p>	<p>Teachers use this app to calculate student's grades. Parents can see class schedule, attendance, class assignments, test scores, etc.</p>	<p>The Lunch payment system. Parents can make a credit card payment on their student's lunch account.</p>	<p>Lists all student names. Student Profile, Student Documents, and School Web store are links that are unique for each student. Lunch balance is updated nightly.</p>
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Within the Parent Portal, there are several ways to access student information. Each application is formatted and presented a little differently. Click through the applications to find the ones that are most helpful to you.

To see your student's grades and missing assignments: Click → Gradebook → Student's Name → Assignments. All classes are listed with % score and current grade. Classes with missing assignments will show  in the far right column. To show details for a class or category of assignments, click the arrow icon > next to the course name or category.

OR Click → Student Center → Student Profile → Course Name. All assignments and scores are shown on the right.

To email your student's teacher: Click → Gradebook → Student's Name → Assignments → Click on the envelope  next to the teacher you would like to email.

OR Click → Student Center → Student Profile → Course Name. The teacher's email is above assignments on the right.

To check your student's attendance: Click → Gradebook → Student's Name → Attendance. All dates the student was absent are shown. To see which periods were missed and if the absence has been excused, click the arrow icon > by the date.

OR Click → Student Center → Student Profile → Course Name. Click on any course. On bottom left is a calendar showing dates/periods missed. A=Absent (not excused); E=Excused by Parent; M=Medical; R=Released for School Activity; etc.

To pay student fees: Click → Student Center → School Web store

To access Fee Waiver Application, Free or Reduced Lunch Application, Beginning of the year Registration Forms, etc.: Click → Student Center.

To see your student's test scores and grade history: Click → Student Center → Student Profile. Click on any underlined text for more information. Some test scores, such as Acuity, have pull-down boxes for additional subjects.

SRI (Scholastic Reading Inventory): a reading assessment. Your student's score is shown for each time they were tested. The first number(s) are your student's approximate reading grade level (for example: 765=7th grade reading level or 1047=10th grade reading level). Levels are color coded by markings and shaded areas of the graph.

SAGE (Student Assessment of Growth and Excellence): Utah's comprehensive assessment system.
