Dear School Administrators,

At the last study session, on April 23, 2019, the Granite District Board of Education approved a change to the process for grade reconfiguration. The change eliminates the need for unanimity for a network to request an informational meeting regarding reconfiguration. Instead, only a simple majority of school council within the network is required to request this meeting. The second step to move towards a community wide survey and final step to formally request reconfiguration STILL require unanimity.

As such, if you have previously submitted a letter from your School Community Council requesting an informational meeting, you will now be required to re-submit so we can tabulate based on the change in this process. The new letter must be dated and signed by the School Community Council Chair, as well as the Administrator. Please submit those letters in care of the Communications Department via email and/or district mail.

We have attached a copy of the updated procedure infographic. Please share with your council members as soon as possible. If you or your council members have any questions. Please email or call me with any questions.

The Board hopes that this change will foster appropriate community level discussion about these important issues. Thanks for your efforts.
