1. Land Trust Budget – Mark
 - All money needs to be spent – no rollovers can be inserted in the budget.
 - Proposal addresses three main areas: aides, technology, and professional development.
 - ESL aides will continue with same hours as last year.
 - Mark will send out request forms for technology needs to teachers.
 - Last year, Trustlands money bought science department 3 sets of google chrome books; year before 2 sets for history department were purchased.
 - Next meeting, Mark will have detailed budget.
2. Registration – Mark
