We reviewed the purpose of community council

Steve Hogan from Granite's Planning and Boundaries department presented a possible change in school boundaries affecting Eisenhower. He presented and we reviewed the district plan to move over about 100 students from Fremont El and Plymouth El to start attending EJHS their 7th grade year who would usually go to Granite Park Jr. This change would happen next school year. No vote was necessary as he was just giving out information.

We are requesting more information, as the addition of 100 kids may mean adjusting classrooms and will require additional teachers. Do the extra kids have special needs or other extra requirements? We also do not want to lose space designated to our computer labs. Computer labs are necessary for testing, printing and other needs.

Sue Weierman brought up concerns about the chromebook usage, as kids are saying that their eyes hurt after working on the chromebooks in multiple classes. The chromebooks are good, but they are not a final solution and we need the computer labs for the students to work in.
