Goal-Literacy

MEASUREABLE OBJECTIVE

1. The percentage of students in performance levels Proficient and Advanced on SRI from the Proficiency Growth Report will increase by 10%.

1. Using Granite Quarterly Benchmark Assessments increase the percentage of students demonstrating proficiency (76-100%) from pre-test to post-test each quarter by an average of 25%.

Action Steps

Literacy

1. The school has double blocked Math for all students except three sections of Math I.

3. Teachers will use benchmark assessment results to guide instruction.
