

Eisenhower Jr. SCC Minutes
February 7, 2018

Meeting Start Time: 3:15 p.m.

Attendees: Ryan Swenson (parent), Tere Gerber (counselor), Kammie Jones (parent), Sue Weierman (teacher/ vice-chair) , Cory Martin (vice-principal), Mark Ellermeier (principal), Christina Anderson (teacher), Fern McLelland (teacher), Marsha Ingram (media specialist), Hillary Dalton (parent, acting secretary)

1. **Approval of last month's meeting minutes:** Proposed by: Mark Ellermeier and seconded by: Ryan Swenson. Approved by all present.

2. **Next year's SSAP & Amendments of this year's plan:** Mr. Ellermeier proposed that \$20,000 be taken from the "Aides" budget and be moved to the "technology" budget to purchase new Chromebooks, which will leave \$45,000 for aides. Ryan Swenson made a motion to approve this amendment and Kammie Jones seconded. This amendment was voted on and approved by all present.

Mr. Ellermeier then talked about the plan for the 2018-2019 Trust Lands Budget, which is due March 23, 2018.

- a. \$45,000 for aides
- b. \$5,000 for Library books
- c. \$10,000 for a Professional Learning Conference. This conference will be held in September and Mr. Ellermeier would like 10 teachers to attend. It is \$700.00 per teacher. In addition there will be money for the substitute teachers who will cover these teachers' classes while they attend the conference.

- d. \$40,000 for ESL Resources. This money may go towards funding a .5 ESL Reading teacher, which will support our Literacy goal.
 - e. \$17,000 for AVID. The success of this program warrants another section offered at the school. This money will cover the cost of a professional development AVID conference.
3. **School Counselors: Ms. Gerber:** The counselors have been busy with 7th grade registration, which includes visiting the elementary schools. They have not reviewed the information they have received from these students yet.
 4. **Report on AVID funds-** There is a summer AVID conference in Anaheim and Mr. Ellermeier proposed that we take \$2,000 from the “professional development” budget and move it to the “AVID” budget to ensure that we have enough money to send 10 teachers instead of 8. The teachers who will be attending include teachers in English, Science, Social Studies and Math. The goal will be to eventually have every teacher attend this conference because it is so excellent.
 5. **School Programs: Feedback on Eisenhower Showcase:** Each year the staff and students at Eisenhower put on a showcase for sixth grade students from surrounding elementary schools. It was well attended, and the humanities departments took advantage of the opportunity to show new students the opportunities available at Eisenhower. Ms. Johansen did an amazing job hosting the event. It was apparent that students and staff alike have an enthusiasm for their school!
