1. **Approval of last meeting minutes:** seconded by Betsy Valora, all in favor of approval

2. **School Counselors:** Ms. Gerber reports student schedules are done, ready for next year.

3. **PTSA – Hilary Dalton**

- Julia Caldwell has volunteered to serve as next year's PTSA President and Sarah Timpson as Treasurer, looking for other parents willing to help, vote still needs to take place.

4. **Future of this Community Council:**

- Community Council funds:
 - Another set of chromebooks will be purchased
 - Ms. Anstead's class will be made in to a full class next year
 - AVID Conference
 - All aides will be retained from this year
 - Less than 10% of budget will be rolled over to next year
- Community Council membership needs:
 - There will be 5 open parent slots on next year's council.
 - Mr. Ellermeier will send out a teleparent calling for volunteers

5. **School Programs:**

- SAGE testing: The state wants to see 95% of students to get tested, often it's hard to reach that 95% because it's not mandatory for students and parents are allowed to opt their children out of testing.
- Staffing changes or needs: Still need to hire a Behavior Unit Teacher, a ½ time FACS teacher and a full time CTE
- Changes in the building: New PBIS signs will be framed and mounted around the school over the summer.
- Next year's Advisory change: Mark will send out a Survey Monkey to all teachers to get input on whether or not they should cover social skills for first 2 weeks instead of just one week during advisory time.
