Reconfiguration Updates:

Teachers who are now teaching ninth grade were given the opportunity to put in a requestion to teach at the high school. Teachers who are now teaching sixth grade were given the opportunity to put in a requestion to teach at the jr. high.

Mr. Ellermeier will know how many teachers plan on leaving to teach elsewhere by January so will know how many openings there will be by the end of January or beginning of February.

Full-Time Educators:

With a little help from the Trustlands budget we were able to keep all of our teachers this year, even with the pandemic issues.

Distance Learning:

Eisenhower started the year off with 329 distance learning students. We are now at 350 and will probably go up with the positive case numbers rising each day.

Counseling Center:

The counseling center will start 5th going into 6th grade registration on January 6th, 6th going into 7th grade registration on January 13th and 8th going to high school on the 21st.

Eisenhower is currently planning an in-person orientation for incoming sixth and seventh graders. If that is not possible a virtual orientation and registration will be planned.

After a faculty vote, Eisenhower will be changing to a 7 period/ 50 minute per class period schedule starting in fall of 2021. Teachers are excited to see students every day and have more time with them during the week.
