Mr. Ellermeier gave us an update on the use of Trustlands money. The school had put aside \$40,000 for several teachers to attend an AVID conference during the summer recess. Because of COVID-19 the district recently told the schools that there will be no trips allowed this school year. Mr. Ellermeier will talk to the teachers and ask them if they have any needs for their classrooms and we will vote on the amended budget next month.

Teachers have until tomorrow, January 14th, to decide whether they want to stay at Eisenhower or move to Taylorsville High. Mr. Ellermeier will then inform the teachers who have applied to teach at Eisenhower next year whether-or-not there is a position for them.

The in-coming 6th and 7th graders have completed their course selection for next year. They are now reaching out to the distance learners. The administration and counselors would have preferred to host the traditional registration night but with COVID-19 guidelines it was impossible. There have been some complaints from parents that they should have received more information about registration but over-all the counseling center is pleased with the amount of registration packets that have been filled out. They will make an effort to reach out to the 5th and 6th grade teachers directly with any further information. For those who are interested there will be an in-person orientation in August, before school starts. Parents are always welcome to tour the school with their student if they make an appointment beforehand.
