- Update on Trustlands: This year we are on track to spend around \$140,000. That will leave around \$9,000 to roll over. We continue to put the priority on smaller class sizes so we will use most of the money for teacher salaries. One year of salaries is around \$72,000-\$75,000. We will plan to help pay for 2 teachers. This helps reduce the class sizes by offering more classes.
- Update on TSSA: We don't know how much money we will get next year. There may be new money available to help kids get caught up from COVID, likely for ELL students and lower testing students. We would like to keep 2 aides besides the aides already in SPED and BHA. We would also like to use some of the money to help keep fine arts classes, maybe by helping to pay a teacher salary.
- Pick-up and drop-off changes: Granite District Police have made some changes to the pick-up/drop-off area by the track. This is to help ensure the safety of the kids who walk and to help with traffic flow. Change has been difficult but is getting better. Officer Randall has been a real asset to our school.
