Vote on Continual Improvement Plan: (attached) Members of the community council voted on the continual improvement plan and it passed unanimously.

What is the role of Granite Police Officer in regards to the faculty parking lot

The officer is asked to be there before school, so parents do not have access to the teacher parking lot. This is not happening. A member of the community council asked that we consider getting an arm that comes up and down to allow only those with district badges to enter. This needs to be addressed at the district level.

Concerns about Instagram videos-- A parent is concerned about the fighting that is being filmed and put on Instagram. Most of these are old fights that they are uploading to several accounts. All students involved have been subject to school/district discipline. The frustration is that less than 5% of Eisenhower students are involved in these fights but they take up a lot of time and energy. Focus on the 95% of good students!

Concerns about Grades not being updated Parents are concerned that grades are not being updated. Students are being punished at home if parents think they are receiving bad grades, students tell them they have their work done but the teachers are just not upgrading them on canvas and gradebook.

Mr. Ellermeier said parents or students should email the teacher first. If they get no response, then email or call an administrator. He also said he will talk to the teachers about this and is hopeful that having advisory on Fridays as a catch-up day will help next year.
