- * Meeting was opened with a welcome from Principal Cutler.
- * We are celebrating our increase in proficiency. We had moderate growth in English and Science (1.1% and 1.4% respectively). But we had a 5.4% increase in Math, the best in Granite School District, by far.
- * We had an interesting conversation about school grades. The state is now changing to a number grade instead of a letter grade. School grades are currently determined by the lowest 25% academically and economically. A school's TSI classification, or special populations that do not perform well, do not have to impact your school IF you are able to increase their scores.
- * The superintendent is encouraging a Districtwide goal to increase proficiency by 1% this year. If you are concerned about your student reaching this goal, please encourage them to log in to IReady at home. There are games they can play which will give them individual help on concepts in which they need to improve.
- * Merri Rygg made a motion to adopt Roberts Rules of Order as the way we conduct our meetings. Ashley seconded it and we voted unanimously to accept the motion.
