Friday Distance Learning Day Expectations

Fridays have been designated as distance learning days for students in both our Secondary and Elementary schools. Students should be afforded the opportunity to learn, using technology or paper-based, while engaged in distance learning. The modality used should be based on a student's need. Students that want to check out a Chromebook and take it home should be allowed to do so. This should give teachers the opportunity to practice distance learning, using technology, so that if or when a class, grade, or school is asked to move into a modified or dismissal schedule they will be prepared. It is <u>not</u> best practice, instructionally, to default to the paper-based model simply to avoid having to check out or collect Chromebooks.

Teachers are expected to work from the school site on Fridays. We have had several administrators ask if employees can bring their children to work with them on Fridays. For a number of reasons (i.e. safety, liability, etc.), employees may not bring their children to work with them on Fridays. Please remember that Fridays are not a day off, they are still instructional days for students and work days for teachers.
