When arriving at school, all students should go to their designated playground and plan to enter their designated classroom doors. Additionally, please be aware that breakfast will only be available to students the first 10 minutes of the school day. Therefore, it is extremely important for all students to arrive on time in order to participate in the breakfast program.
