Assessments for Gifted and Talented Programming:

Assessments for Granite District's Gifted and Talented Programming will take place in early February. This testing is for students currently in Kindergarten and first grades in order to consider placement in programs for the 2018-19 school year. If you would like your child tested, please let his/her teacher know.

School Fundraiser:

Let's get excited about how they can help support our school, kickoff assembly will be on February 13th. Look for your student to bring home more information at that time. This fundraiser will run from February 13th to the 28th.

Cold Weather and Pollution:

Please make sure students come dressed to go outside during the winter as recess opportunities are important, but we also need students to be safe. We monitor both the temperature and the air quality to determine whether students will go outside at each recess. Based on standards set by the Utah Department of Health (UDOH) and Utah Department of Environmental Quality (UDEQ), there are days that we will keep all students inside (if particulate matter is above 90 ug/m³) and days when we will need to keep "sensitive students" (those with significant or poorly controlled asthma, cystic fibrosis, chronic lung disease, congenital heart disease, compromised immune systems, or other respiratory problems) inside (if particulate matter is above 35.5 ug/m³). Please let the office know if your student qualifies as a "sensitive student".
