All incoming Kindergarteners will be tested between August 6th and 8th, please make sure to sign up for a testing time when you register. As a reminder, Kindergarteners must turn 5 on or before September 1, 2018. You must bring with you proof of immunizations, birth certificate, proof of residency in our boundaries (utility bill or rental agreement in the parent name) and photo ID for parent or legal guardian. We will be offering full day Kindergarten (OEK), AM or PM classes, please mark your order of preference when registering. You will be notified regarding your child's program placement no later than August 13th, 2018.
