#### Creating a Safe and Positive School Environment

The Fox Hills Faculty and Staff continue to develop and implement universal plans and procedures for maximizing safe, positive behavior at the school. With the support from Granite School District, the Utah State Office of Education, Utah State University, and parent/community input, the following components have been established and are reinforced as a school-wide plan:

- Fox Focus: Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be Responsible
- Fox Focus Rules in 14 Common Areas
- Fox Hills Respect and Social Responsibility Curriculum Taught
- Universal Leveled Behaviors and Consequences
- Positive Reinforcement Plans (ticket drawings, recognition, etc.)
- Classroom System Plans and Grade Level Policies
- Due Process Procedures for Disciplinary Infractions

### Leveled Behaviors & Leveled Consequences

A system for categorizing and responding to various behaviors within the school has been developed to help ensure prompt and appropriate response as well as provide a leveled system of due process for students, parents, and staff. Detailed information regarding this system is available upon request. Following is a summary of the procedure:

LEVEL I: Minor rule violations that are brief and low intensity

Consequences are handled by the teacher

LEVEL II: Moderately serious or deliberate violations that are

more frequent and intense

Consequences are handled by the teacher and parent

LEVEL III: Major rule violations that are serious/severe or chronic

Consequences are handled by administration

#### Things Parents will Want to Know

In supporting this system on behalf of the safety and well-being of all students of Fox Hills Elementary School, parents will want to know the following key points:

- Behavior slips, Classroom Behavior Logs, and Office Discipline Referrals (ODR) will be used to document and track disciplinary issues.
- Grade level Inclusion Criteria have been established for determining a student's opportunity to participate in any Power Party or Term Reward Activity (talk to your child's teacher for details). Any ODR (referral to administration) will result in loss of reward activity privilege without exception.
- 3. Teachers have the authority to develop additional contingencies for reward activities to be distributed in writing to parents at the start of school or prior to designated activities.
