Approved Minutes from January

Safe Walking Route – Kylie and Teri met with Steve Hogan and Dave Gaddy to discuss our concerns. The walking bridge will not be finished until May 2021. Kylie is working to make sure we have the needed crossing guards to get the kids across 6200 S safely and will be contacting Taylorsville about getting the school crossings marked and with lights. If during the construction of the new intersection at 6200 and Dixie Drive it is unsafe for kids to be walking through the construction area, a temporary bus bridge will be set up. We were concerned about how to let parents and kids know the safest route. It was suggested to use balloons or chalk or signs to mark the route and to recruit parents to walk with the students to help them know where to turn during the first few days of school. We will be updating the online map during the summer to have it ready for registration.

Right now the spending is looking good for this year. No amendments are needed.

2020-2021 Land trust plan discussion

We want to improve Math, reading, and science and we may want to include some BHA and Counseling help too. We may want to include ½ FTE in case we don't have the all day kindergarten (there is a bill before the legislature right now). We should look into another way to fund the Studies Weekly and the teachers have requested a training on how to use "Donors choose".

Course and Student Enrollment Priorities – it is looking like we may be overfull for next year with the boundary change and there is some concern about the old relos not working well. With the 6th grade reconfiguration we

may have one year that is tight and then some space should open up. Numbers are still coming in.

NetSmartz is back under contract with the State of Utah so we are planning to get an assembly. Since morning Kindergarten will not be able to attend we will try to have Krystal Plott teach them a lesson too.
