Minutes from October were approved with the following adjustment: Voted and approved .5 floating substitute or interventionist.

Approved the child access routing plan or safe walking route. No changes were needed. The pedestrian bridge is useable and is close to being complete. Teri is going to check that a locking gate to the school grounds is still on the plan for the project. We believe Steve Hogan is the contact to answer this question.

Course and student enrollment priorities: Numbers as of October are 590 students. This is allowing for 3 teachers/ classes per grade, not counting ALC teachers. We have a high number of kids in our Kindergarten and 1st grade classes, 26-28 per class. Teri has posted a position for a .5 interventionist to be used in classes with highest number of students

School Improvement Plan: The goal is to see a 3% increase in our Acadience (math) and Dibels (reading) test scores. The plan is to use Para's and specialists to work in small groups with those that need more support. Also use tether or break off groups according to student's abilities. ELL (English Language Learner) students are struggling. The school is implementing new strategies this year to help them. The Vice Principal met with each ELL student at the beginning of the year. Brenda suggested that there needs to be better outreach to parents of ELL students.

Diana reported back that Jennifer Williams, the school tech. specialist (STS) has made upper and lower grade Near Pods for digital citizenship available through google classroom. Diana will talk to Jennifer about adding a tracking system for the teachers to add the date they completed the Near Pod for the month.

Needs for next year: Possibly replace the computer lab, which is rarely used now that everyone has a chrome book, with a STEM lab.

Is it possible to get the dirt field west of the visitor parking lot paved?
