Minutes from September's meeting were read and approved.

Current student enrollment is at 567. This is just above the level needed to keep 3 full time teachers per grade, in addition to 1 ALC teacher per grade. Our enrollment numbers have been in a constant decline over the last several years, causing the loss of about 1 teacher per year. Some of these "losses" have been from teachers retiring and not replacing them.

Teri presented the Schools Continual Improvement Plan. Highlights include goal of 2% growth in acadience math score. 2% growth in rise tests. School Social Worker(s) working with the kids on growth mindset, mindfulness and respect lessons.

Land Trust money has been going, and will continue to be used to pay for paraprofessional's, \$1000 for new library books and \$2000 for field trips.

The safe waling route(s) were reviewed and approved. Our national walk to school day went well. It was noted that some parents are choosing to walk their kids across the crosswalk at the 6200 S. intersection instead of using the sky bridge. Teri will remind the kids during announcements to use the sky bridge.

Council Members were invited to watch the training videos about community council's role

It was voted to cancel the meeting for December 8, 2022.

It was voted to relocate the community council meetings from the family center relo to inside the school's large conference room 2B.
