

Robert Frost Community Council  
April 23, 2015 Minutes

Those present: Beckie Hennessy (parent and Council Chair), Kim Overdiek (Parent), Amy Ross (Teacher), and Mr. Andy Carbaugh (Principal).

Chair, Beckie Hennessy, welcomed all present and called the meeting to order.

Minutes from last month's meeting were approved.

Items Discussed:

Mr. Carbaugh reported that the soccer goals have been purchased and will be installed before the next school year begins. The council discussed different options regarding how to prevent theft issues that may arise.

Mrs. Hennessy reported that she passed out fliers to adult males who attended the school Art Show. She reported that she will be coordinating the Eagle Eyes as part of being next year's Volunteer Coordinator with the PTA. Once there is a male who has been identified as someone to chair that, she will discuss that with him and have him chair the Eagle Eyes program.

Mr. Carbaugh and Mrs. Ross discussed desires to make the school vision/mission something that it easy to remember. It was discussed that this could be something put on the pack of school shirts in the future. It was reported that it will be something that is a big part of next year.

The council discussed the safe walking routes. Both Mrs. Overdiek and Mrs. Hennessy reported that sidewalks will be installed during the summer that lead to Robert Frost. The exact locations of those walks are unclear. It was agreed by the council that safe walking routes be part of the agenda for the first Community Council meeting in the 2015-2016 school year.

Mr. Carbaugh reported that vacancies for next year have been posted on the school website and that declaration forms will be included in registration packets next school year.

Mr. Carbaugh reported that he would be submitting the new plan, discussed in previous meetings, online and that he will be emailing the council for electronic signatures to the plan.
