Transfer funds from the hourly teacher salary category \$7,508.00 to the technology supplies category to purchase 33 new touchscreen chromebooks.**
- **Frost will need to surplus one teacher. Mr. Moore will ask for volunteers, then consider school needs, and lastly seniority in the district.**
