- ❖ Students are to come to school dressed appropriately for the day.
- ❖ Inappropriately dressed students will be sent to the office and they will need to change/fix their outfit.

The following are things to consider to maintain dress code standards:

- ❖ Costumes must meet dress code: no midriffs or underwear worn outside of their costume. Costumes must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- ❖ Hats are acceptable if they are part of a costume, can be removed for class, and are not a distraction for others learning.
- Costumes should not impair the student's ability to function in class, move through the halls, eat lunch, or cross the street.
- Props or costume parts should not obstruct other students or be a distraction in class.
- * No weapons or facsimile of weapons are allowed.
- ❖ Makeup and colored hair are fine as long as they are applied at home. Do not bring colored sprays to school. <u>Face makeup is</u> <u>allowed but faculty and staff must be able to</u> identify the student.
- **Halloween Masks are not allowed –** your face must be identifiable.
