

## **Gourley Elementary Community Council Meeting Minutes**

**Wednesday, October 22nd, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 p.m. by Chairman Jones. Those in attendance were Brandon Jones, Paul Stoker, Allesen Peck, Kim Edwards, Leticia Gutierrez, and Bekah Spencer

Kim Edwards and Leticia Gutierrez were official voted in as council members by parents on the committee.

The council asked that the school survey the community through a ballot home regarding their feelings about Halloween celebrations at school.

The council watched and discussed the Land Trust video and community council training PowerPoint.

Principal Peck reviewed the final report for the 2013-2014 Land Trust plan with the council. She reported that a summary of the report had been sent home to parents and that the summary was also available on the school web page.

Principal Peck presented a draft of the school SSAP plan for 2014-2015 to the council. The plan was voted on and unanimously approved by council members.

Chairman Jones reported that he had been approached by a parent requesting that speed bumps be placed in the street that runs in front of the school in order to slow down the traffic. Chairman Jones indicated that he would contact UDOT to see if that would be the appropriate agency to work through on this issue. Principal Peck also mentioned that sometimes there are grants available through UDOT to install electronic speed monitoring signs around schools.
