- 1). Community Council Elections: There are 2 openings on the council this year. Notes were sent home Aug. 2, 2016 for parents to fill out if they are interested in serving. They must be notified by Sept. 16th if there will be an election. If so, elections will take place during SEPs.
- 2). Land Trust Budget: There is an additional \$2000 available in the budget this year. Allesen proposed that the money be used to purchase medals for students who achieve their goals. This will not cover the total cost, but will help get things going. After parent input in favor, the council voted to accept the money being spent for the medals.
- 3). SAGE Testing: Allesen shared with each member a copy of the school's overall SAGE results for the last 3 years. This information can be accessed online. It was shared that there has been significant growth across the grades and feels we are beginning to make the progress we want to see at Gourley. Brandon asked if there was a correlation to the implementation of the Reading Intervention program. Allesen shared that DIBELS is used to assess the data for that that she can share with the council during the year.
- 4). Brandon addressed the "traffic calming zone" signs on the street north of the school. They were up for a period of time, but are now gone. Members felt this helped slow traffic down on the street and perhaps we will want to contact West Valley City again about putting them back up.
- 5). Allesen shared that the School Emergency Plan has been updated. Our evacuation plan has the back field as the on-site location and if we have to leave the school we will be going to West Kearns. We have all of our emergency drills scheduled for the year (fire, earthquake, lockdown, and the releasing of students).
