#### School Performance Report –

- Achievement – developing (lags behind growth)
  - English Language Arts 28.2%
  - Mathematics 27.8%
  - Science 33.1%
- Growth – typical (our shining point) – lowest 25% now counted twice
  - English Language Arts 50.5% **high** (out performed district/state)
  - Mathematics 39.4% **typical**
  - Science 44.5% **low**
  - Growth of lowest 25% - 75.8% **high** (out performed district/state)
- English Learner Progress
  - English Learners' Adequate Progress – 45.3
  - English Learners Reaching Proficiency – 4.9
- Points weighted to overall score
  - 67/150 typical overall

#### Land Trust –

- Budget Amendment
  - New just plug in the numbers – motion to accept
- Current Plan
  - There is an overage – motioned to carry over funds to next year
- Plan for 2019-20 – motion to accept
  - New policy the teacher in the program funded by land trust must be the teacher paid by land trust.
  - Fund the reading intervention program - .5 teacher salary (other .5 coming from Title One budget); 1.5 paras to work in reading intervention room.

#### Grade Reconfiguration –

- District – it's hard to have networks on different configurations.
- Gourley seems to be the lone hold out to move to next phase – sending survey to whole community.
- KJH asked if they could come present their ideas/plans – we will invite them to April 4<sup>th</sup> meeting and will invite community include Oquirrh Hills incoming students.
- School will put together invitations for community.

- Looking at two choices for reconfiguration
  - Network way – decision was given to networks. If decision is to move 6<sup>th</sup> grade to junior high looking possible at this years 4<sup>th</sup> graders (2020-21).
  - Board Study Meeting – during this meeting one agenda item is reconfigurations – district making the decision.

Update on Oquirrh Hills Consolidation –

- Projected to have 95 students join us.
- FTE is based on assumption all will come
- Overall \$14,000 increase
- Allesen has a preliminary staffing plan she will present to staff.
