Grade Reconfiguration –

- KJH principal had to cancel
- Allesen Peck summarized reconfiguration information and what is happening in the Kearns Network (David Gourley only hold out).
- Emphasis on what is in best interest of students.
- Questions from parents:
 - Would curriculum stay the same?
 - Curriculum would stay the same, but not sure of instructional model.
 - It happens if Gourley gives its' okay?
 - The district would give a community wide survey.
 - What does the data show about 6th grade students in Jr/Middle school setting?
 - We don't have the information – Ask KJH principal or district to give the data.
- Concerns of program services – many students are not ready from Aug. – Dec. for a Jr. High setting
- As of now community has a voice and parents would like 6th grade to stay in elementary, but are willing to look at data.
- As of now our vote is no, but will invite principals from Kearns and Kennedy again to come and discuss what they envision 6th grade to look like in Jr. High.
- Request a meeting in Sept. (might try for May 2, 2019) for principals to bring data and share the plan/s they are thinking of using.
- Concerns of program services – many students are not ready from Aug. – Dec. for a Jr. High setting
- District could make changes that would be district wide.

- Looking at two choices for reconfiguration
 - Network way – decision was given to networks. If decision is to move 6th grade to junior high looking possible at this years 4th graders (2020-21).
 - Board Study Meeting – during this meeting one agenda item is reconfigurations – district making the decision.
