

# Community Council Meeting Minutes

**February 1, 2018**

Council Members in Attendance: Brandon Jones, Amy Peterson, Shellie Averett, Allesen Peck, Megan Holmes.

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. He welcomed several parents who do not sit on the board to the meeting and thanked them for coming.

The first item on the agenda was council membership. Principal Peck announced that due to Mrs. Jewkes' retirement, Megan Holmes would be serving as the faculty representative on the council for the remainder of the school year. Chairman Jones reminded the committee that we still needed a parent representative to fill Kim Webb's seat. Parent, Candy Montero volunteered to take that seat on the council as did parent, Yasmin Sita. A motion was made by Principal Peck to expand the CC board allowing both parents to sit on the council. Chairman Jones seconded the motion. Chairman Jones called for a vote. It was unanimous in the affirmative. Both parents will serve as one year members. Their seats will be declared vacant at the end of the school year.

The second item on the agenda was selecting a photography vendor for the school. Principal Peck presented pricing sheets for Eastman Adams, Bell Photography, and Lifetouch to those present. It appeared that pricing was important to those present as well as customer service. After some discussion, Principal Peck made a motion to accept Bell Photography as the vendor for school pictures for 2018-2019 school year. Chairman Jones seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Principal Peck discussed the Land Trust grant with the council and answered questions from parents about the program. She reported to the council that the budget was still on track to be spent by the end of the school year with minimal carry over.

Principal Peck shared with the council that a private sponsor has stepped forward to fund the cost of a permanent food pantry at the school. The pantry will be set up in March in room 9. The hours of operation have not yet been set. Principal Peck shared that this would be a great service for our community.

Chairman Jones opened up the floor for any comments or concerns from parents. In the absence of any, the meeting was closed at 4:00 p.m. The next meeting of the council will be on Thursday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, at 3:30 p.m. in the school conference room.
