### Land Trust Final Summary Report and Implementation and Success of Land Trust Funds –

  - Sign next meeting – more in attendance
- 2018-19 summary review
  - Goal #1 – improve reading proficiency rates through a reading intervention program. 80% of initial students will test out by reaching grade level benchmark using DIBELS Next.
    - Overall 78% of initial students reached the goal.
  - Action Steps
    - Funds will be used to hire full-time certified teacher and part-time aide in reading intervention room.
    - Use DIBELS Next BOY to identify students
    - Students will receive 45 min. targeted instruction
    - Weekly progress monitoring will be done in reading intervention room
    - Collaboration between intervention teacher and classroom teachers
    - Students will receive strong tier 1 reading instruction in their classrooms
  - Financial Report
    - Itemized expenditures with a carry-over of \$4,466
- 2019-20 Land Trust Plan
  - Quick review of 2019-20 plan
    - Fund reading intervention room
    - Target intensive readers as well as strategic readers
    - Reach a composite score for grade level DIBELS benchmark, not just fluency (wpm) benchmark.
  - Financial Report
    - Estimated expenditures - \$85,831
