SSAP – School Student Achievement Plan - *UPDATE

- 2018-19 Gourley received a “C” – some push back due to testing malfunctions, but this didn't seem to affect all teachers. - *UPDATE – district took appeal to state (testing issues), state said no scores stand

Update on Construction –

- Some projects moved back
 - Elementary schools averaging 28-30 million
 - Jr. High schools averaging 30-35 million
 - Sr. High schools 75-145 million

School's PBG Plan

- District/network community council has concerns – it's been reported that some teachers will not give 4's. Dr. Bates said for schools to request specialists if there is a need to train teachers.
- Students should know what the criteria is to receive each number grade
- Emphasize students have the right to retake
- PBG is to evaluate and grade proficiency not behavior – use citizenship for behavior.
- Reevaluate assessments times – they should not be the last week of the quarter.

Maturation

- Best practice is for principal to work with PTA – principals in charge/PTA is a supportive role
- There are 4 programs to look at
- Schools cover cost of presentation
- Permission form is opt in
