PBG (Progress Based Grading):

- We are a PBG school. All schools will be moving to PBG approx. 2021-22.
- PBG use to be 3 assessments on standard with a decaying average with the last being worth more, but all counted toward grade. It was hard to get 3 assessments and give time for retakes, if needed, and get a clear idea of what students need. Now it is teacher discretion based on rigor. The last assessment will determine proficiency and will be able to use multiple modalities for assessments. This change will help teachers know where to focus instruction.

Reconfiguration:
