Safe Walking:

- Boundaries didn't change. Motion to accept what is already in place. There is one "hazard" or "red" area, but Hawk(?) is in place there. All in favor.

2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22

- 2019-20
 - BOY-MOY
 - 18% improved 1 or more levels
 - 63% had 30 points or high growth
 - Followed guidelines for distance learning Mid-March through the end of the year – provided digital platform and paper lessons.
 - Carry over monies from aide hours has not been fully utilized yet.
- 2021-22
 - Intervention room ELA/COVID continue to improve all areas of reading fluency.
 - Intensive students
 - 50% of students that start in the intervention room will test out (through PM or MOY/EOY)
 - 80% of students that start in the intervention room will meet or exceed their POP goal
 - Supplies purchased
 - Program Learning A-Z
 - Headsets with microphones
 - Fountas and Pinnell materials
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 - Receiving less money from Land Trust – mostly due to enrollment. Enrollment declining through district, but many elementary schools are losing 6th grade.
 - Some money going towards:
 - Program Learning A-Z
 - Headsets with microphones
 - Fountas and Pinnell materials
 - .5 FTE/ 1 para
 - Receiving RRESS (Relief Recovery Economics School Stimulus)
 - Summer program for intensive students kinder-4th grade
 - Para's pay
 - Possibly save a teacher if needed
