#### **Our three School Improvement Goals are:**

#### 1-Academic Learning Goals

1a. On the 2023 RISE assessment, Granite Park's school MGP will increase from 44 to at least 49 in all RISE tested subjects. \*We are currently at 42.

## 2-Social Skills and Dispositions Goals

2a. During the 2022-2023 school year, the overall daily student attendance rate will meet or exceed 90%. We are currently at 85%

#### **3-Talent Development Goals**

3a. Granite Park will reduce the number of teachers leaving our school at the end of the year by 50% (from 10 last year to no more than 5). We have had 1 teacher resign this year.
