 - a. RISE Proficiency (Report compares GPJH to similar schools)
 - b. MGP (Median Growth Percentile)
 - Our goal: 5% growth in proficiency – See CIP goal below)
 - Even a 2% growth is large
 - 40+ → 1 yr growth, 65+ → 1.5 yrs growth, 70+ = \$7k bonus for teacher
 - c. Growth Measure (GPJH has 8 reading sections for interventions for 6th-8th grade; 1 teacher has reading endorsement & 3 more are

working on theirs currently; Land Trust Plan is aligned with Growth Measure)
