School Land Trust Plan 2022-2023

Goal:

Each grade level will see at least a 20% increase in the number of students who are <u>On</u> <u>Level or Above Level</u> on the Growth Measure Assessment by the end of the year compared to the beginning of year assessment taken in the fall.

Granite Park Jr. will improve reading scores by lowering class sizes in English courses. We will also continue promoting a culture around 1.5 and 2.0 growth. We will continue to promote a school culture of student growth by requiring students to set Growth Measure Assessment goals in their ELA classes

This focus will help us achieve our overall school goal of improving our student proficiency in ELA, Math, and Science.

Measurements:

The following measurements will be used to measure the success of this goal: Students will progress towards On Level or Above Level in reading comprehension and proficiency on the Growth Measure Assessment which is administered three times a school year; fall, December, end of year in March.

Current Action Plan Steps:

- We will hire an additional teacher ELA to help lower class sizes. Teachers will meet weekly in PLCs to plan and implement reading and writing strategies. Teachers will also utilize district resources to make sure instruction provides students with appropriate remediation and extensions.
- Students will be encouraged to try their best on the baseline assessment taken in the fall. ELA teachers will then work with students to set reading comprehension goals in ELA courses throughout the year.
- Teachers and students will also monitor their progress towards meeting their goals.
- Granite Park will also celebrate student growth after taking the Growth Measure Assessment.
- Teachers will track and evaluate interventions needed for students who aren't making progress towards On Level or Above Level proficiency on the Growth Measure Assessment.
- Any funds available will be spend on purchasing leveled books for students to access and use in ELA classes to further promote a culture or student reading throughout Granite Park.
