

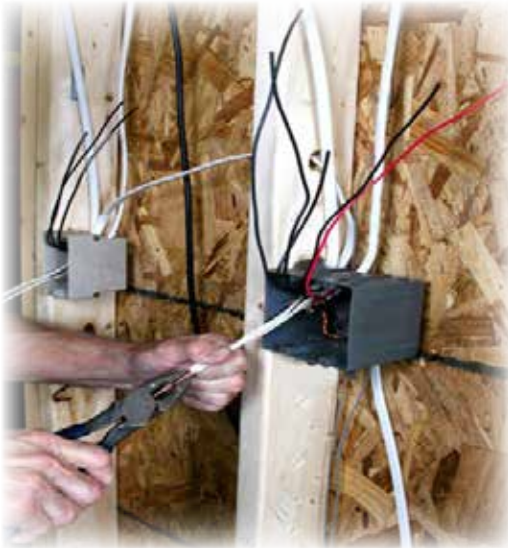

General Information



When to Start: 10th, 11th or 12th grade

Courses included:

First semester SLCC apprenticeship-related instruction curriculum for plumbing or electrical (Plumbing 1A or Electrical 1A)

College Credit: Concurrent enrollment,

5 credits per course, required for apprenticeship credit

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Steps of High School Apprenticeship:

- Enroll in the plumbing or electrical course in the Granite School District
- Available to 11 & 12 grade
- Obtain employment in the plumbing or electrical field (Students under the age of 18 fall under the School to Registered Apprenticeship Linkage Program Addendum, sponsored by the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Department of Labor. This employment may count as OJT hours, if the business feels it is warranted.)
- Continue with part-time employment during high school
- After graduation, make a seamless transition from the high school apprenticeship program to full-time apprenticeship employment and related instruction



Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in the plumbing or electrical classes in Granite School District
