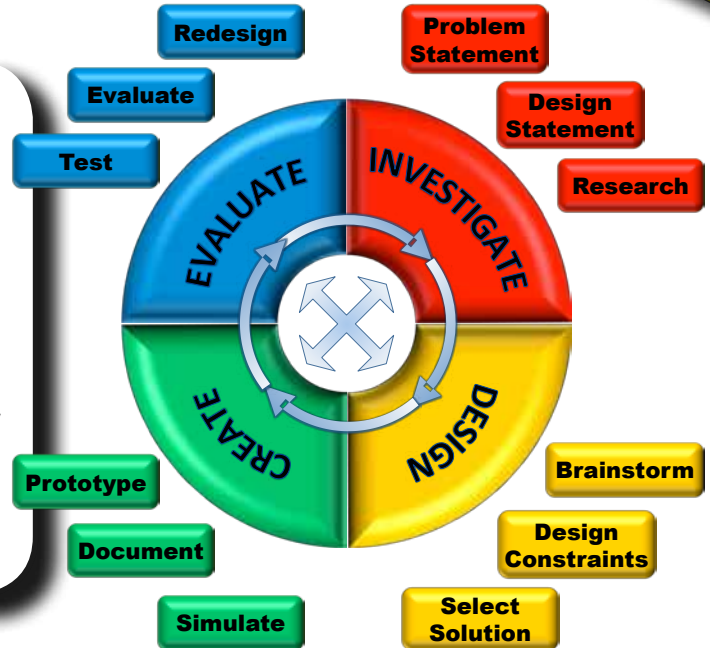

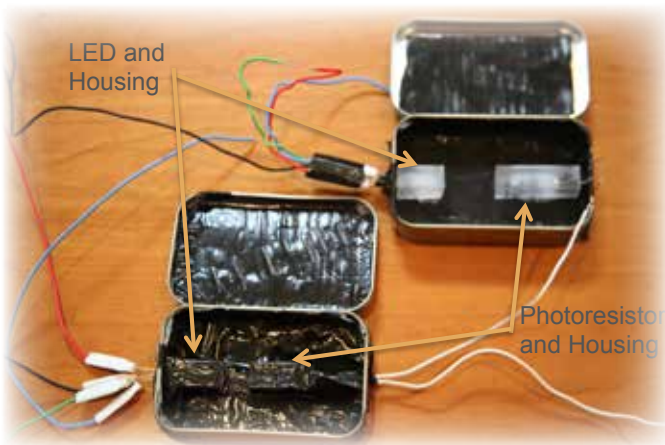

This research course requires students to formulate solutions to open-ended engineering questions. With a community mentor and skills gained in their previous courses, students create a project with written reports on their applications, defend the reports, and submit them to a panel of outside reviewers at the end of the school year.
