This is a program that prepares individuals to perform the duties of a firefighter. Instruction includes training in safety, firefighting, equipment operation, maintenance, and the principles of fire science. This high school based firefighter development course is derived from Utah State Fire Fighter Standards, NFPA, IFSAC, current Unified Fire Authority standards and the experience of an instructor cadre from multiple jurisdictions.

Program Expectations

- Due to some strenuous physical activities, the student must pass a physical entrance test and must obtain a physician's approval based on such requirements.



Costs/Fees:

- UVU Concurrent Enrollment Fee: \$35 + \$5 per college credit hour
- Required Fee: \$40 class fee per semester
- Optional Fee: \$156.00 – Firefighting textbook, workbook, uniform shirts Skills U.S.A. membership (nominal CTSO membership fees vary)
- Students must purchase their own NFPA approved firefighting gloves, hood, and structural firefighting boots
