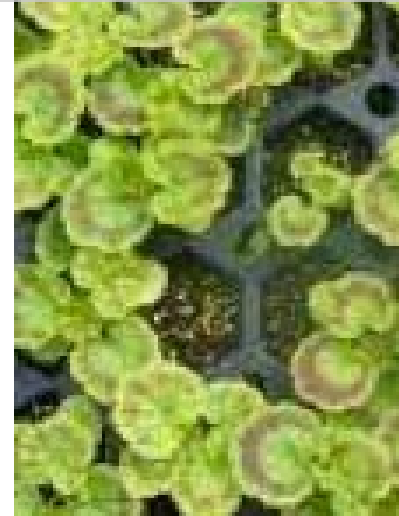


Intro to Horticulture
