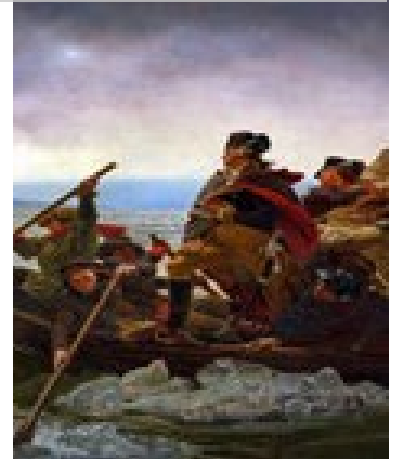


HISTORY CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT



Geography 1300: Cultural Geography (IG)

The purpose of this course is to focus on the cultural and geopolitical regions of the world. This includes the introduction and analysis of historical and current cultural, geopolitical, economic, and environmental issues in relation to these specific regions of the world. Students will gain experience researching and presenting geographic essentials in a collegiate framework. Emphasis will be laid upon how geography is critical to understanding the world in which we live.

History 1700: American Civilization Pre-Columbian Period to Present (AI)

This course covers American History from the Pre-Columbian period to the present. It provides an examination of the major social, political, economic events, issue and themes in the period. The course should enable students to think, discuss and utilize the implications and applications of our historical heritage to meaningful ends as self-reliant and self-thinking citizens

Topics Covered

- Political, economic, demographic, physical and cultural geography of the nations of the world.
- Key events in American History: understand why they took place, how they apply to and help explain modern events, and to introduce students to some of the fundamental disciplines of studying history
