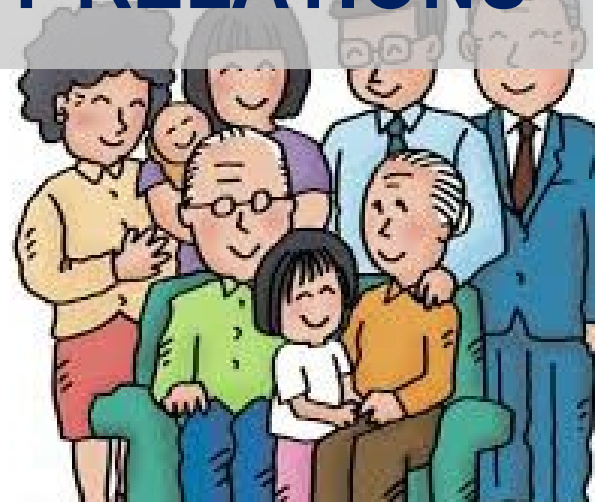


MARRIAGE AND FAMILY RELATIONS
