Externships- 160 hours are required as part of the 4th quarter and will extend beyond regular school hours

Students will have the opportunity to become certified as a phlebotomist through the Utah School of Phlebotomy, and CPR certified through the American Heart Association for additional fees.

Must be 18 by March 1st to attend the University of Utah, or Granger externship experience.

Benchmark Exams: Medical Terminology, Anatomy & Physiology, Medical Office Administration, Clinical Laboratory (to obtain the USOE certificate, you must have an accumulative score of 80% to pass).
