Requirements:

For any student interested in licensing and certification to work as a Pharmacy Technician or basic pharmacology to support health science pathways.

Students will have the opportunity to complete 180 hours of externship. Externship can run through the summer (until August 1st) if needed to accommodate course load.

Must maintain 80% average and completion of externship to receive state licensure

DOPL Trainee license required (if pursuing externship). *Fees apply. Social Security number needed for state licensing.
