Community Council Meeting Minutes


Hartvigsen School Administrative Conference Room March 12, 2024, 10:00 – 11:00 AM

<u>Welcome and Introductions</u>: Felicia Wood, Karen Kwal-senator, Niesha Nelson, Alison Wendel Bennett, Erolynne Wood, Mary Martha Tripeny, Alisa Harmon, Crystal Morris Shank, and Kym Fry virtually.

<u>Minutes</u>: February 2024 minutes read by Alison Wendel Bennett. **Motion**: Alisa: "To approve the minutes from the January 2024 meeting as amended." Kym, seconded the motion. The committee unanimously approved.

Business:

1. Student Progress data overview: 86% of students improved from baseline during music based learning.



- 2. Land Trust money for increased Technology Coach time next year:
 - a. It will be between \$23,000 and \$25,000.
 - b. Felicia read the goals for Hartvigsen Land Trust for the 2024-2025 school year.
 - c. Motion by: Alison, seconded by: Niesha "That we use the Land Trust Monies to fund a Home-based learning and Technology Coach for two additional days per week to help implement with fidelity the new curriculum programs and technology hardware just purchased for classrooms."
- 3. Technology Funds and Technology rotations of equipment
 - a. We are on the rotation from the district for our teachers to get new laptops next year.
 - b. The technology team is helping to support the technology needs for weekly sing-along lessons.

- 4. TSSA funds to be used for the following: Home based learning and Technology Coach. (There are additional funds if needed.) 7 classrooms are going to get a new large vinal bean bag.
- 5. New Land Trust plan for Hartvigsen and Addendum for Jones Center presented. Both related verification documents were signed. Jones center receives 1/3rd of the joint Land Trust Land, Hartvigsen receives 2/3rds.
 - a. Granite Transition Proposition for Land Trust presented for approval.
 - b. Call for a motion to approve Kim approved and Alisa seconded the motion "To approve the Granite Transition Center amendment for the Jones Center." Unanimously approved by the committee.
- 6. Update from PTO on Multicultural Night: It will be postponed until next year. The goal is to create committees in the fall who are over specific events.
- 7. Discussion held regarding the possibility to involve other special schools with the Multicultural Night.

Action Items:
