- Over the break, the total number of puzzles completed in ST Math reached a quarter of a million. We now stand at 255,148 puzzles done this school year. That is an amazing number!
- 116 Students worked on ST Math over the break. That's about 1/5 of the school went above and beyond during the break.
- We've spent a total of 5,864 hours as a school on ST Math this school year to this point. That's a lot of hours! That's about 11 1/2 hours for each student!
- 84 students worked on Lexia over the break and 11 students worked on Imagine Learning over the break. That totals to 95 students who worked on ELA over the break! That's about 1/6 of the school who went above and beyond during the break.
- We have had 60 of our students this year go from studying below grade level to on level and higher since the beginning of the year in Lexia. Of those, 3 of those students moved into that category during the Break.

Meeting was called to order at 5:02 by Karen Bates. Minutes were looked over from December's meeting. Cindy Davis motioned to approve the minutes for the month of December, it was seconded by Sydney Graybill, and was unanimously approved by the SCC committee.

Dr. Longberg asked that everyone introduce themselves, allowing us to get to know one another.

The Land Trust and TSSA budget was tabled for the next meeting in February. There was not much change to the report since there were only two weeks of school in session from when we last met in December.

Jadee Talbot and Jodi Lusty are in the process of putting together focus groups for Hillside. They will start to reach out to families for one on one interviews soon. Dr. Longberg asked if members of the SCC would be willing to talk with them. Members on the council agreed to participate in the focus group.

Hillside students worked hard over the break with ST Math, Lexia, and Imagine Learning. $\frac{1}{5}$ of the school participated in ST Math over the break and $\frac{1}{6}$ of the school participated on either Lexia or Imagine Learning.

The roll out for the schools Math Priorities have started. Posters have been made and hung up around the school with each grade level's Math Priorities. 3 X 5 cards have been made with the math priorities on them for teachers to send home with their students. Dr. Longberg sent information on it before break, but will send more information on it now that we are back from break. All parents should be notified and familiar with the Math Priorities by this time next month.

Dr. Longberg asked if there was anyone on the committee that would be willing to look over and revise the dress code section in the Student-Handbook. A sub committee of Marie, Sabrina, Sarah, and Cindy will come up with a draft with a revised dress code for the Student-Handbook.

The video for before and after school safety looked really good. One adjustment that will be made to the video is they will start with the importance of crosswalks and where the crosswalks are located. Once that adjustment has been made the video will be rolled out to families to view. Dr. Longberg will also send out a PDF of the before and after safety plan.

There is still a concern of people cutting in front of others in the parking lot which backs up traffic.

Dr. Longberg would like input from the SCC on how to use the funding for next year's Land Trust. A possible consideration for next year would be to pay aides and extra support staff to help in the building with Land Trust money and use TSSA money to buy and replace new Chromebooks along with paying for a .5 FTE to make 1 FTE.
