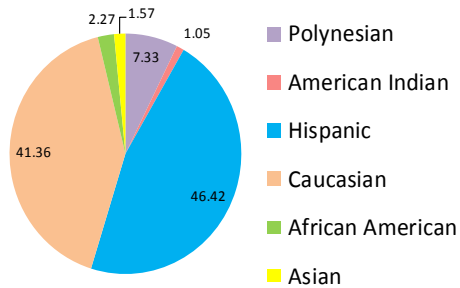


Demographics:
