Addressed the Mountain View Highway project completion and the UDOT project to mitigate air pollution. The filtering has been completed at a cost of \$377,000 and filters out about 98% of the pollutants in the air.

New High School and Elementary Science Standards are being updated and the process has been started. They were last updated in 2002.

School grading has been set aside for one year and the State Board is hoping to develop a system that would do away with it permanently.

A new committee has been started that will be looking at technical and computer science education and updating curriculum for those requirements.
